RESOLUTION # 18-006

ON STREET PARKING REGULATIONS

The Board of Trustees of Springfield Township, Lucas County, Ohio, met in regular session on April 2, 2018 at 7617 Angola Road, Holland, Ohio, with the following members present:

Robert Bethel, Tom Anderson, Jr.

Tom Anderson Jr. moved the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the Board of Township Trustees believes that on-street parking shall take place in a safe manner in Springfield Township;

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code authorizes a Board of Township Trustees to regulate on-street parking;

THEREFORE, it is **RESOLVED** by the Springfield Township Board of Trustees, Lucas County, Ohio, in the interest of public safety and the general welfare, to enact the following parking regulations:

- 1. The storage or apparent storage of vehicles and/or recreational vehicles and trailers in the street is prohibited. A vehicle/trailer may be considered as being stored if it meets any of the following descriptions: Is in the same position for 30 days or more, has flat tires, is considered a junk vehicle, or is under a cover or tarp.
- 2. No parking is permitted over public sidewalks.
- 3. Vehicles shall be parked within 12" of the curb.
- 4. Commercial vehicles shall not be parked in the street, except while loading and unloading, if such loading/unloading can be done safely.
- 5. No vehicle parked in the street shall be parked in a way that creates a safety hazard or that blocks vision.
- 6. Any vehicle found to be in violation of this resolution may be subject to tow if not moved within 24 hours of a written notice. Any vehicle found to be a safety hazard shall be considered an emergency and may be towed at any time at the owner's expense.
- 7. Whoever violates this Resolution is guilty of a minor misdemeanor; and
- 8. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the latter of (i) thirty (30) days following posting of this Resolution in five (5) conspicuous places in the township, and (ii) publication of this Resolution in a newspaper of general circulation in the Springfield Township for three (3) consecutive weeks; and

9. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

Robert Bethel seconded the motion, and the roll was called on the question of its adoption. The vote was as follows:
