# Springfield Township Trustees Regular Trustees' Meeting

The Springfield Township Trustees met in regular session, open to the public, on Monday, April 16, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. in the Township Chambers, 7617 Angola Road, Holland, Ohio with the following members present:

Andrew Glenn called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. All present were asked to rise for a silent prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

# **ADOPTION OF AGENDA:**

Motion made by Tom Anderson Jr. to approve the agenda, as presented. Seconded by Andrew Glenn and the roll call resulted as follows:

#### **PUBLIC SAFETY:**

Sheriff's Report:

Capt. Luettke presented the Crime Report for March. Trustee Glenn asked Capt. Luetkke for an update on the ongoing vandalism that is taking place in the Connecticut/Rhode Island neighborhood. Capt. Luetkke stated they are aware of the situation and are monitoring it, and they will help them set up a block watch for their neighborhood.

#### PUBLIC SAFETY (cont.):

Fire/EMS Report: By Barry Cousino, Fire Chief

Chief Cousino reviewed the March Monthly Report and highlighted the following items:

- Chief Cousino and his staff attended several meetings/events including:
  - o Community Leadership Summit
  - o Emergency Operations Center Workshop
  - Lucas County 911 Communications Board Meeting

  - Unified Command MeetingFire Inspectors Training Courses
  - o Polish American Festival Planning Meeting
  - Anne Grady Emergency Preparedness Committee full scale evacuation drill
- Fire/EMS responded to 231 calls in the month of March, of which 36 were in the Village of Holland, and 36 were in the Spencer Township service area.

Chief Cousino presented the Trustees with a request for maintenance and installation of snow guards on the roof at Fire Station #3.

Motion made by Tom Anderson Jr. to approve the contract for maintenance and the purchase of the snow guards to the roof at Fire Station #3, from Masin Roofing, Inc, at a total cost of \$3,300. Seconded by Andrew Glenn and the roll call resulted as follows:

Chief Cousino presented the Trustees with a request to purchase a stair-chair.

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Motion made by Tom Anderson Jr. to approve the purchase of a stair-chair from Stryker, at a total cost of \$2,988.12. Seconded by Andrew Glenn and the roll call resulted as follows:

Chief Cousino presented the Trustees with a request to pay for tuition for four Springfield Township Fire/EMS employees, through our tuition assistance program, for their Paramedic Training Class.

Motion made by Tom Anderson Jr. to approve the tuition payment for four paramedics, as presented by Chief Cousino, through Four County Career Center, not to exceed \$3325 per employee. Seconded by Andrew Glenn and the roll call resulted as follows:

Trustee Glenn stated that he received a phone call from RJ Lumbreezer, complementing the Fire Department on the caring and professional service that they provided them during an emergency call at their residence.

FISCAL OFFICER'S REPORT: Barbara Dietze, Fiscal Officer Mr. Hampton filled in for Ms. Dietze, who could not attend the meeting.

Motion made by Tom Anderson Jr. to approve the payment register of payments made by check from April 3 to April 16, 2018, in the amount of \$55,311.55 as presented. Seconded by Andrew Glenn and the roll call resulted as follows:

**PUBLIC SERVICES:** By Andrew Hohlbein, Director of Public Services

Mr. Hohlbein reviewed the Monthly Report and highlighted the following items:

Mr. Hohlbein presented the Trustees with a request to contract with a local company for the 2018 Crack Seal Program. Mr. Hohlbein looked at bids from local companies and their bids came in lower than the County's bid.

Motion made by Tom Anderson Jr. to accept a bid from Buck Brothers to perform the 2018 Crack Seal Program, at a total cost not to exceed \$30,000. Seconded by Andrew Glenn and the roll call resulted as follows:

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- Upon research for a new dump truck, Mr. Hohlbein discovered that the 2018 models are no longer being made and the State Bid quotes are not available for the 2019 models.
- Mr. Hohlbein presented the Trustees with a request to purchase a grinder pump.

Motion made by Tom Anderson Jr. to approve a purchase of a grinder pump from Covalen, Inc., at a total cost of \$2,780. Seconded by Andrew Glenn and the roll call resulted as follows:

- Mr. Hohlbein presented the Trustees with a request to approve the over-the-budget expenses on the back building, which were due to roof and flooring repairs.

# PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION: By Mike Hampton, Administrator

Mr. Hampton reviewed the Public Administration's Monthly Report and highlighted the following items:

- Mr. Hampton gave an update on the JEDZ Board Meeting. Mr. Barnes will proceed with getting the Business Advisory Board up and running. The report of businesses in the JEDZ will now be updated on a quarterly basis, instead of annually. Our Law Directors are working on a resolution to lease a township employee to perform work for the JEDZ Board.
- Mr. Hampton is looking to finalize the Intergovernmental Agreement for the Dorr St. Interchange later this week, and he is also continuing work on the JEDD contract.
- Mr. Hampton, Township personnel, Sheriff's Office members, and the Chamber planning members held the first meeting for the planning of the Freedom Celebration.
- Jim Shaw, Sanitary Engineer, is rescheduled for the next Trustees Meeting.
- Mr. Hampton presented a press release from First Energy, where they are offering a free energy audit program.

Tom Anderson Jr. moved to adjourn at 7:33 p.m. Seconded by Andrew Glenn and the roll call resulted as follows:


