Fire/EMS Report: By Barry Cousino, Fire Chief

Chief Cousino reviewed the December Monthly Report and highlighted the following items:

- Chief Cousino continues to chair the Medical Committee for Lucas County EMS.
- Springfield Township Fire Department is experiencing a shortage of Paramedics, to help relieve the situation we are teaming up with Four County Career for paramedic training. We currently have four interested firefighters who would like to take the training classes.
- There were three structure fires in the month of December.
- Training throughout the month included a scene size up command course, five metrics of CPR, and an interactive drill for winter operations.
- Fire/EMS responded to 222 calls in the month of December, of which 38 were in the Village of Holland, and 50 were in the Spencer Township service area.

Other items:

Chief Cousino presented the Trustees with a request to purchase a new ambulance which includes power load and cot systems.
