Laura Koprowski, CEO of TARTA, described the new route that is operating in the Airport Highway corridor, as well as introducing a new on demand service named FLEX. She explained that multiple forms of payment are accepted on the vehicles and that additional offerings are available for seniors. She also wanted to confirm that upgrades to the bus stops are forthcoming once the designs have passed final approval.

<u>PLANNING AND ZONING</u>: By Jacob Barnes, Planning Director Written Report:

- In the month of March, 29 permits were issued, including 2 new dwellings.
- The BZA approved a variance request for multiple accessory buildings and a high fence and pool, for the property located at 11 Tremore Way.
- Several on-street parking issues were addressed.
- Given the expanding number of solar installations in the area, Mr. Barnes proposed initiating a text amendment to develop solar regulations for the Township. The Trustees agreed but also wanted to investigate light pollution regulation, as this has become an issue with greenhouses in neighboring areas.
- Reviewed the plan for "Dorr Street Station Plat 1", northeast of the interchange.
- The JEDZ business inventory is rescheduled for April.
