## **PUBLIC SERVICES:** By Andy Hohlbein, Director of Public Services

Mr. Hohlbein reviewed the Monthly Report and highlighted the following items:

- The Township guardrail areas have been cleaned up.
- Storm sewer repairs were performed.
- The 2022 state salt contract was awarded to Morton, at a price of \$52.94/ton.
- The Township has changed petrol suppliers to Lyden Oil.
- Both the 2020 and 2021 OPWC projects are close to completion.
- The concession stand in Community Homecoming Park was painted. Other upgrades are planned for this and next year.
- The park fountain has been repaired and preparations made for Party in the Park.
- Motion made by Tom Anderson Jr. to re-appoint Jeff Crowell to the Park Advisory Board for another five year term, commencing on 8/21/21. Seconded by Robert Bethel and the roll call resulted as follows:
