PUBLIC COMMENT:

David Budge, WXE Development representing Circle K for development in Springfield Township. Circle K is proposing a gas station/convenience store on 2 of 5.6 residential-zoned acres at King and Hill. Rezoning to C2 is required. Trustees are open to commercial use but stressed buffering, landscaping, and aesthetics to protect neighbors, while noting concerns about maintenance and the number of existing gas stations. County engineer approval is needed for traffic access/curb cuts, and the developer should consult on traffic issues. Trustees remain cautious, recommending county review as the next step in the process.

Josh Hollinger, Zoning Inspector, 7617 Angola Road, Holland, OH sworn in by Rachel Geiger. The board considered a request to rezone Plats 12–14 from RA to R1 (Single-Family Residential), with Platte 15 north of the pipeline to remain RA. The request is consistent with existing R1 uses south of the pipeline, aligns with prior zoning changes, and has the support of the Trustees, Lucas County Planning Commission, and Springfield Township Zoning Commission. Planned lot sizes are approximately 11,000 square feet, which exceed the R1 minimum of 7,200 square feet. The rezoning was found to be consistent with surrounding residential development while maintaining larger lot sizes.

- George, Oravec, Consulting Civil Engineer. Proposal for the development of single-family residential lots on the east side of Gunn Road, consistent with existing development on the west side. The lots are slightly above the RA minimum width and approximately 1,000 square feet smaller than R1 standards. Planning Commission and Township staff recommend approval. Proposed homes will be approximately 2,000 square feet with three-car garages and priced around \$500,000 or more.
- Bernard and Anne Drouillard, 7560 Garden Road, Holland, OH 43528. Concerns raised regarding the lack of parks in the area and fire safety/speed limits on Gunn Road.
 - Response from Township – there is no park land in this part of the Township. A recent traffic study from Pilliod Road to Airport Hwy determined that lowering the speed limit to 25 mph did not meet requirements, so the limit remains 35 mph. Once development begins, the Township will request a new study for this section of Gunn Road, which may result in a lower speed limit, with the final decision to be made by the County Engineer.
- Response from Trustees – noted that the higher density along the county road transitioning to lower density further in is appropriate. Builders were recognized for their strong track record, and the development is consistent with the surrounding area. Traffic and speed concerns were acknowledged and will be addressed by the county once development begins.




