Fire/EMS Monthly Report, Jonathan Ziehr, Fire Chief

Fire and Rescue Operations Highlights

- Chiefs Ziehr and Sauder hosted their monthly meeting with Fire Inspector Bockelman regarding the fire prevention bureau. Since February 10th Scott has performed over 1400 events (annual inspections, site permits, plan reviews, and firework permits). Inspector Bockelman's hard work and dedication to the safety of the community and firefighters is unmatched.
- The new Battalion Chief vehicle was placed into service. This vehicle will continue to provide command and leadership throughout the area, every day, staffed by four Battalion Chiefs.
- Chiefs Ziehr and Vascik attended an initial meeting at UTMC to discuss whole blood use in the prehospital setting. All healthcare systems and the red cross were present at this ground level meeting.
- Springfield Township Fire and Rescue went live with the newly contracted EMS Billing company EMSMC on the first of November. The switch was made to EMSMC to gain a better rate and potentially increase revenue. STFD administration and Springfield Township Finance Director Evans meet with EMSMC weekly to ensure the transition is without issue.

Public Relations

- On duty crews escorted the SHS marching band providing a sendoff to the state championship. STFD supports the Blue Devils and is proud to accompany them during these events.
- Lieutenant Kohler and the HERO Program teamed up with The Ability Center of NW Ohio to provide an in-home Hoyer Lift System to a community member in need. This great opportunity was highlighted by local media, and the patient receiving the equipment was extremely thankful for the assistance.

Training

- A protocol review for first responders was designed and instructed to be used for training and procedural awareness for fire, and EMS personnel. In-house training ensures our personnel are up to date with policies and procedures.

ZONING INSPECTOR REPORT: Josh Hollinger, Zoning Inspector

Permits and Fees

- Fifteen permits for the month of November.
- \$1,210.00 in fees received.

Violations

- Junk and Debris
- Non-permitted Construction – a few violations have also increased due to non-permitted construction, with many complaints about structures being put up without approval. New construction situations are treated as a learning opportunity: violations are issued when necessary to ensure they are on record, and property owners are then guided through the permitting process to achieve compliance.

2026 Zoning Fees included in packet

- Existing Sign/Structure fee – the township currently charges a \$100 fee for any sign face change, treating it as a new sign permit. This applies even when an existing frame and foundation are reused, including cases where an existing business updates its sign or a new business replaces the sign face. Trustees questioned whether this approach is appropriate, noting that face-only changes require significantly less review since setbacks, size, and location are already established. There was general agreement that a reduced fee—rather than the full \$100—may be more reasonable for simple sign face changes to document the update while still allowing for basic review.
 - Administrator Hampton was asked to draft proposed language and bring it back to a future meeting, potentially as a fee schedule update or code-related amendment, for further consideration.


