YEAR 2026 PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS

The Board of Trustees of Springfield Township, Lucas County, Ohio, met in special session, on March 26, 2026, at 7617 Angola Road, Holland Ohio, with the following members present:
Andrew Glenn, Tom Anderson Jr., and Rachel Geiger

Andrew Glenn moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, Resolution 25-034 provided temporary appropriations for year 2026; and

WHEREAS, Springfield Township has submitted an Amended Certificate of Estimated Resources for year 2026 to the Auditor, Lucas County, Ohio dated March 26, 2026, which indicates total revenue of \$36,951,829.58.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Springfield Township Board of Trustees as follows:


1. That the Board of Trustees adopts this Resolution in order to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Board of Trustees during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2026; and
2. The sums set forth in the 2026 Permanent Appropriation Schedule attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A be, and the same hereby are, set aside and appropriated as set forth in said Schedule for the several purposes for which expenditures are to be made for and during said fiscal year.
3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

Rachel Geiger seconded the motion, and roll was called on the question of its adoption.




