RESOLUTION # 26-012

**ASSIGNING TO THE TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR DUTIES UNDER
OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 505.87 ABATEMENT, CONTROL, OR
REMOVAL OF VEGETATION, GARBAGE, REFUSE, AND OTHER DEBRIS.**

The Board of Trustees of Springfield Township, Lucas County, Ohio, met in special session on June 25, 2026, at 7617 Angola Road, Holland, Ohio, with the following members present:

Bob Klumm, Thomas Anderson Jr., and Rachel Geiger

Rachel Geiger moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, Section 505.87 of the Ohio Revised Code enables a board of township trustees to abate, control or remove vegetation, garbage, refuse and other debris from land in the unincorporated area of Springfield Township; and,

WHEREAS, Section 505.87 provides the procedure to be followed by a township to abate, control or remove such vegetation, garbage, refuse and other debris from land in the unincorporated area of a township; and,

WHEREAS, Section 505.032 of the Ohio Revised Code permits a board of trustees which has appointed a township administrator to assign to such administrator any office, position or duties under its control; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Springfield Township Board of Trustees, Lucas County, Ohio:

1. The Board of Trustees assigns to the Township Administrator its' duties under Ohio Revised Code Section 505.87 *Abatement, control, or removal of vegetation, garbage, refuse, and other debris.*
2. These duties shall be performed under the direction and supervision of the board and to be in addition to those set forth in Ohio Revised Code Section 505.032 *Powers and duties of township administrator.*
3. Any action taken by the Township Administrator under this Section 505.87, shall be reported to the Board of Trustees at their next regularly scheduled meeting following such action.
4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.




